Education Report – Dawn Darter

Successful rules seminar was conducted in conjunction with the Spring meeting. Rules seminar was given by Jay Fox of the ASGA, and there were 17 in attendance.

Senior Report – Mike Socha

The tournament schedule is set for 2023. Membership in senior organization continues to grow.

Assistant's Report – Zac Taylor

Finished the year with approximately \$4,000 balance in assistant's fund, with the anticipation of additional expenses to be applied from the Assistants Benefit. It was mentioned that the Assistant's championship is looking to be moved to a summer date.

Tournament Report – Mike Jonges

The chapter tournament schedule is set. There are still a few open dates TBD. Players can view the schedule on the chapter website and Facebook page. It was reiterated that the competition yardages for tournaments will follow along with the section guidelines.

Junior Tour Report – Matt Fraser  
Net operating funds to begin the year are around a \$10400 balance. Junior Tour is currently looking for a Northeast Regional Director.

Membership Report – Scott McClinton  
Reported that total chapter membership ended for the year with 129 members (113 members and 16 associates. 6 members were considered suspended (3 members, 3 associates).

Presidents Report – Dawn Darter  
Dawn thanked Barry Howard for hosting the spring event, along with Jay Fox for conducting the rules education seminar. Dawn thanked Brian Cheever and Clear Creek Golf Cars for their continued support, specifically the \$6000 sponsorship for 2023. Dawn thanked all the officers and committee chairmen for their work this year. She also thanked Cary Maddox for his work with the Arkansas Junior Tour. Thanks was given to Mark Ramer for maintaining and managing the chapters web presence. Dawn also congratulated all of the Chapter Special Award Winners, along with special recognition to Bruce Baxley and herself for Section awards.

District Director Report – Barry Howard  
Barry reported on and took questions about the progress of the PGA of America working on a deferred compensation benefits package for PGA members. He indicated there would be more information on the pga.org site. He reported on main topics from the annual meeting about retention of golf professionals and the focus on the revamping of the education and the development of PGM 3.1. He also solicited feedback regarding the purse of the PGA Championship. There was discussion about increasing the purse for the event in order to keep up with the other majors.

## 5. Old Business

Chris Mayes led a discussion regarding the Golf House to be developed at Burns Park. Some of the plans include changing a few of the holes to accommodate the range and short game area. Planning and development will continue with the committee with support from the city. There were some challenges that came up regarding the initial incorrect measurements at the property. The committee is beginning to seek donations for the project with a fund-raising goal of \$13 million.

## 6. New Business

Dustin Ralston wanted to make everyone aware of the Ralston Family Foundation in which they give scholarships to 1 boy and 1 girl, graduating from an Arkansas high school and playing collegiate golf. They are looking for nominations for scholarships and anyone that is interested in serving on the selection committee.

The officers recognized all the chapter award winners along with awarding them recognition plaques. Special attention was given to the two Section award winners, Bruce Baxley and Dawn Darter.

The Arkansas PGA Junior Tour has endured for over 4 decades. As times change, it is important to move forward for the program. Next year the Junior Tour will join the South Central Section will be under the Foundation umbrella. This means more opportunity for our juniors in Arkansas to gain experience, have more competition and gain more exposure for future playing opportunities. We have \$17,900 in our Junior Golf Account that may be used for Membership scholarships or go to developmental programs for the juniors in Arkansas.

These are the guidelines for those wishing to host an event in our Chapter. All SCS members will be able to compete in these events.

#### SCS Junior Golf One Day Information

Goal is schedule completed and done by February and membership and entries are open. Emails go out to all Juniors in our database to let them know schedule is online/open.

#### Membership \$80

##### Entry Fees:

9-11 Boys & Girls (nine holes) \$35

12-13 Girls (nine holes) \$35

12-13 Boys (18 ) \$50

14-15 Girls & Boys \$50

16-18 Girls & Boys \$50

The Section will take all entry fees through BlueGolf- entry deadline for tournaments closes at midnight 3 days before tournament. Based on what the course wants – we set tee times the next morning and it is emailed to the course for approval and then emailed out to all participants and go live. We can limit the number of participants for the course if needed. We email the course the tee times, a basic rules sheet that local rules can be added, scoring instructions, yardages and spectator guidelines.

The courses that host the event are required to run the event – make score cards for the kids, start the kids, enter the scores into Blue Golf (we provide directions), be the rules officials, make sure water is provided and available, and hand out awards. Awards are mailed to the courses before the event.

After scores are entered by the course – the head golf professional is emailed an invoice from us to sign to receive payment. Courses are paid \$30 dollars for every child that tees off and plays 18 holes and \$20 for every child that tees off and plays nine holes. Course also makes any money for carts that are rented by parents that come to watch and of course any other golf shop or food expenses the participants and/or family buys.

#### Example for a course:

55 (18 hole kids) @ \$30 = \$1,650

20 (9 hole kids) @ \$20 = \$400

\$2050 to the course from us.

Anyone interested in running an event, please let Dawn Darter or Joyce Cherblanc know. These are 1 day events and if we could get course participation in all areas of the state, more kids will have an opportunity to play.
